The Road to Tallahassee Runs Through Oak Run—Continues April 29. Last October, “The Road to Tallahassee Runs Through Oak Run” featured gubernatorial candidate Byron Donalds. This April, the momentum continues with a special Governor’s Forum featuring Republican candidates running for Florida Governor.

The Republican Club at Oak Run will host the forum in Palm Grove on April 29. Doors open early for seating and fellowship, and the program begins promptly at 2:00 PM. Seating is limited and advance tickets are required.

The Senior Living (55+) Committee are Oak Run resident volunteers responsible for ensuring the ongoing compliance with the State, Federal, and Oak Run Country Club Deed Restrictions and Covenants as amended June 16, 2004, relative to age and occupancy restrictions of properties within the community.

The Oak Run Homeowners Association may, but shall not be required to, grant reasonable residential deviations from the requirements so long as the deviation shall not cause non-compliance with the provision of applicable law, as amended. No approval or grant of deviation shall be effective unless made in writing and signed by the authorizing member of the Association. No deviation shall be approved for more than three (3) years. Anyone requesting an extension of an approved deviation shall do so in writing at least ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of the deviation. The granting of any deviation or the granting of an extension of any deviation shall not be construed to create any obligation on the part of the Association to grant any subsequent deviation or extensions. Deviations are non-transferable and nonassignable.
