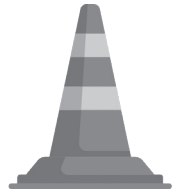

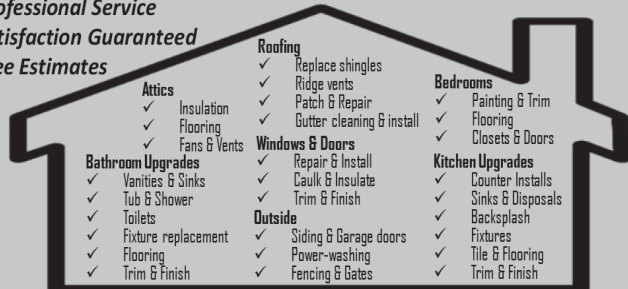

Strict adherence to these requirements helps preserve Oak Run as a legally compliant, active adult community offering a high quality of life for all residents.

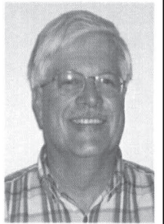

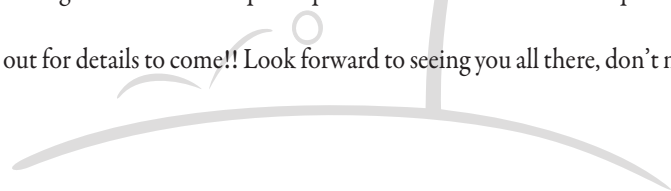

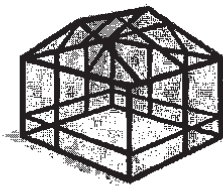

Hurricane Preparedness for North Central Florida

Hurricane season is coming, and now is the perfect time for Oak Run residents to get ready. Even though North Central Florida is inland, hurricanes and tropical storms can still cause damaging winds, heavy rain, flooding, power outages, and tornadoes.

Take some time now to assemble a basic emergency kit with water, nonperishable food, medications, flashlights, batteries, pet supplies, and copies of important papers. Charge phones and backup batteries before a storm, review your insurance and important contacts, and ensure you have multiple ways to receive weather alerts.

It is also wise to create a simple plan. Know where you would go if officials gave instructions and check on neighbors who might need extra help. If you have medical, mobility, or transportation concerns, make arrangements early.

Preparedness doesn't have to be complicated. Small steps taken now can make a big difference later and help keep our community safer and calmer during storm season.
