The summer months are upon us and with the hot weather comes the usual afternoon thunderstorms that can produce severe lightning. Add that to the fact that we live in an area considered to be the lightning capital of the world, and we can expect to deal with interruptions in your cable TV services.

DECCA Digital Solutions employs power supplies within the cable TV network, which in turn are powered by electric company (Seco). During lightning storms, we may experience cable TV outages associated with the loss of power, depending on the area in which power is serving the cable TV power supply. Because of this factor, in some cases your neighborhood may NOT be experiencing a power outage, but you will still experience a cable TV outage. In other cases, we can also experience outages due to damage caused by direct lightning strikes, causing outages by either damaged cables or damage to electronic equipment.

Let's be mindful of the fact that lightning is unpredictable. Lightning packs more than 35,000 amperes of current and can travel as far as 40 miles. Unlike the myth we all have heard, lightning can and does strike the same place twice. Having said this, keep in mind that no matter the type of protection you purchase or how much you pay, a direct hit from lightning strike may or may not save your valuable electronic devices or home appliance. However, some protection is better than no protection at all. The best protection we can suggest is to unplug the power and disconnect the cable from your TV, set-top box, or modem. This is the only sure way to prevent any damage to your valuable devices.

Remember once the storm has passed, you will need to reconnect your cable and plug in your electronic devices to your electrical outlet. Our suggestion is that you take pictures of how your cable is connected to your electronic components before you disconnect any device. This will save time and frustration later on when you attempt to connect everything back.

Remember, with your DECCA High Speed Internet, connect the cable TV cable to your modem first and then plug it in to the power source. Summer is here and it has already been warm here in Florida, so I thought we could discuss playing in the heat. One of the most important things to remember is to conserve your energy. We will discuss 5 ways to help you accomplish this. The first thing to remember, and you would think it was obvious, is to stay hydrated. Drinking plenty of fluids during the round is important but is not enough. You should really start your fluids at least 1 day prior and avoid caffeine and alcohol. On those hot days you will lose fluids from your body quicker than you can replenish them. The second piece of advice is to wear loose, light colored clothing preferably with the moisture wicking material. The worst feeling is your shirt sticking to your body and having to peel it off after your round. This moisture wicking fabric pulls moisture from the body to the exterior of the shirt where it can evaporate more easily. Another piece of clothing you should never be without is a hat. A baseball style hat would do fine, but one of those bucket hats with the big brim that goes all the way around your head is better. It will help you avoid sunburn but also help you maintain that energy level of yours. A third precaution to take is to wear sunblock on your exposed skin. I would tell you that at least 50 SPF wouldn't ever be too much. They now also offer clothing that has sun blocking properties in it. Wearing a long-sleeved shirt with the right materials would give you a good amount of protection from the sun. The fourth thing to remind yourself of is to eat before you play. It is best if you eat light, but make sure you eat something. When you want to maintain your concentration and energy, starving yourself is not going to help. I made this mistake many, many years ago when I took my Player Ability Test for my PGA Membership. I was nervous that day and decided not to eat anything before I went out to play. Not a good decision on my part because mid-way through the round I started to get woozy in the heat. The last portion of advice for you on one of these hot days is to make sure you still warm up before your round. I would suggest that your warmup be light, so you don't zap too much energy. All of us golfers know that Mother Nature is a big part in playing the game. If you prepare yourself before battle, you will definitely enjoy your day a lot more.

I want to invite everyone out to play in our 9 hole 4-person Wednesday Night Scramble we play every week. Check in at 3:30pm with a shotgun start at 4:00pm. Join us for a fun afternoon of golf and friends and end it with some good food and drinks in the Oak Room Bar & Grill. Don't miss out!! Sign up in the Pro Shop.
